POSITION SUMMARY:

The Membership Representative delivers excellent service to all members, guests, and program participants. Responds to member and guest needs, promotes memberships and programs, and maintains cleanliness and organization of the lobby area. Also responsible for cash drawer, facility operations, and security of facility each morning and evening, when Directors are not present.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- 1. Entry level position.
- 2. Responsible for building security and maintaining the facility during staffed hours.
- 3. Provides excellent service to members, guests, and program participants in the Y and on the phone, contributing to member retention.
- 4. Conduct interviews and/or tours responsive to the needs of prospective members; sells memberships.
- 5. Builds relationships with members; helps members connect with one another and the YMCA.
- 6. Handles and resolves membership concerns and informs supervisor of unusual situations or unresolved issues.
- 7. Applies all YMCA policies dealing with member services and facility monitoring.

<u>Mission Advancement</u>: Accepts and demonstrates the Ys values. Demonstrates a desire to serve others and fulfill community needs. Recruits volunteers and builds effective, supportive working relationships with them. Supports fund-raising.

<u>Personal Growth</u>: Pursues self-development that enhances job performance. Demonstrates an openness to change, and seeks opportunities in the change process. Accurately assesses personal feelings, strengths and limitations and how they impact relationships. Has the functional and technical knowledge and skills required to perform well; uses best practices and demonstrates up-to-date knowledge and skills in technology.
